### **To Teach the Right Way**

*Excerpted from The Mother's 'On Education'*

*"When you take the children very young, it is wonderful. There is so little to do: It is enough to be. Never make a mistake. Never lose your temper. Always understand.*

*And to know and see clearly why there has been this movement, why there has been this impulse, what is the inner constitution of the child, what is the thing to be strengthened and brought forward – this is the only thing to do; and to leave them, to leave them free to blossom; simply to give them the opportunity to see many things, to touch many things, to do as many things as possible. It is great fun. And above all, not to try to impose on them what you thing you know.*

*Never scold them. Always understand, and if the child is ready, explain; if he is not ready for an explanation – if you are ready yourself – replace the false vibration by a true one. But this... this is to demand from the teachers a perfection which they rarely have.*

*But it would be very interesting to make a programme for the teachers and the true programme of study, from the very bottom – which is so plastic and which receives impressions so deeply. If they were given a few drops of truth when they are very young, they would blossom quite naturally as the being grows. It would be beautiful work."*

Dear Parent,


Thank you for attending the parent orientation program. We shared our thoughts and expectations regarding our children education.

He was a man of simplicity and selflessness. Let us follow him as a good social reformer.*

## **Life History of Kamarajar** **Dharshan, Std 2**

*Kamaraj was born on July 15, 1903 in Virudhunagar. His real name was Kamakshi Kumaraswamy Nadar. His mother's name was Sivakami Ammal. His father name is Kumaraswamy Nadar. He went to School Kshatriya Vidyalaya. At the age of 16, Kamaraj enrolled himself as full time worker of the congress. On April 13<sup>th</sup> 1954, Kamaraj became the Chief Minister of Madras. He was the first Chief Minister who was in the post for a long period of 9 years. In 1964 Kamaraj was elected the president of the All India Congress. He attracted every one to his side. He listened others. He never concentrated on his food or dress. During British regime the education was only 7%. But in Kamaraj's period it was 37%. His period was called as golden period. He died on October 2<sup>nd</sup> 1975. He was honored with the highest Civilian award the Bharat Ratna in 1976.*



## Marshini. G, Std 7



*I am the moon talking to you,*







## **Kshema, Std 7**


## **Bharathi, Std 5**


