#### Do you know why we celebrate Teacher's Day on September 5th?




Must seem like any other day, right? Well no! September 5th is Teacher's Day. But, did anyone ever wonder why that day is considered special and celebrated as Teacher's Day?

As a mark of respect and to recognize teachers' contribution towards the society, most countries celebrate Teachers Day. In India, we observe it on September 5th, the day President Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Virswami was born. It is said that when Dr. Radhakrishnan became the President (1962-1967), his students and friends wanted to celebrate his birthday.

Known for his humility, he said, "Instead of celebrating my birthday, it would be my proud privilege if September 5th is observed as Teachers Day". Since then, his birthday has been observed as "Teachers Day".

#### SOME FACTS ABOUT DR. RADHAKRISHNAN

- Dr. Radhakrishnan was the first Vice-President of India and the second President of the country (1962-67).
- In April 1909, he was appointed to the Department of Philosophy at the Madras Presidency College.
- In 1918, he was selected as Professor of Philosophy by the University of Calcutta.
- From 1931 to 1936, Dr. Radhakrishnan was the Vice-Chancellor of Andhra University.
- From 1936-39, he was the Spalding Professor of Eastern Religions and Ethics at Oxford University.
- In 1939, he was elected Fellow of the British Academy.
