'Indian Certificate of Secondary Education' (ICSE)

The Council for the Indian School Certificate Examination is committed to serve the nation's children, through high quality educational endeavours, empowering them to contribute towards a humane, just and pluralistic society, promoting introspective living, by creating exciting learning opportunities, with a commitment to excellence.

The Indian Certificate of Secondary Education has been designed to provide an examination in a course of general education, in accordance with the recommendations of the New Education Policy 1986.

'Indian School Certificate'(ISC)

At Primrose Schools, we believe that no compromise can be made with regard to academic excellence. This is the very foundation of our school. We are very happy and proud to introduce the Higher Secondary-Education, Indian School Certificate, under the CISCE curriculum. The Indian School `Certificate examination (ISC-Class XII) can be taken after the completion of a two-year course study under the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE – Class X).

Our school does the judicious preparation and study, before choosing the course books. The prescribed text books not only ensure learning of

concepts but also enable our children to pursue effective application of the concepts learnt. Apart from the books, we also allocate substantial time for project work and practical classes to make sure that theory they learn is backed up with practical knowledge.

Through ISC curriculum, the school gives:

- a wide range of exposure to our children
- empowers them to think, understand and identify their true strengths and passions
- moulds them into 'thinking individuals' who have the capability to assess
- defines their career paths and goals

Prim Buds - Kindergarten

Curriculum— Primrose follows fully integrated kindergarten teaching methodologies, for pre-primary classes. It is a blend of various methodologies like the Montessori Method, Dr. Glenn Doman's method, smart boards for best audio-visual experience and Wize-floor which is an interactive kinesthetic learning system imported from Denmark.

The school also provides an exclusive "Mom and Me" program for the children of the age groups 18 months where the mother along with the child explores the love of learning. "Toddler" program helps children of age 24 months and above, encourages curiosity and to discover the environment around them. The school also provides day care environment for the working parents.

Promotion Criteria

Pre-Primary - There will be no terminal examinations. Assessments will be carried out by the teacher on day to day work of the students. Parents will be given feedbacks on open days.

Curriculum

The school follows a comprehensive program that uses experimental and research-based methods that ensure the sound understanding of concepts. The books are based on the latest syllabus recommended by ICSE (Indian Certificate of Secondary Education) board. Each topic of the syllabus is covered exhaustively using a narrative and critical approach which makes learning an easy and enjoyable experience.

System of Assessment

Classes I to V – Students of classes I and V will have three terms. Each term will have four Formative Assessments (FA) of 10 marks each which will be conducted during the academic term and one Summative Assessment (SA) of 40 marks at the end of the term. Best of FA 1, FA 2 and the best of FA 3, FA4 will be added to summative assessment along with the internals score (40 marks) to arrive at the final score (100 marks) at the end of each term.

Prim Stars (Classes VI to XII)

Curriculum

The school follows prescribed text books ensuring good exposure to application-oriented learning through a number of project work and practical classes.

Promotion Criteria

Classes VI to VIII- Students should pass in English, an Indian Language and Mathematics, to attain a satisfactory standard in other prescribed subjects at the examination. The evaluation of the work of the students will be on the basis of both the result of the examination and of the

project work done during the year.

In standard IX, the conditions for promotions will be the same as those for passing the I.C.S.E. Examination.

System of Assessment

Classes VI and VII — Students of classes VI and VII will have three terms. Each term will have four Formative Assessments (FA) of 10 marks each which will be conducted during the academic term and one Summative Assessment (SA) of 60 marks at the end of the term. Best of FA 1, FA 2 and the best of FA 3, FA 4 will be added to summative assessment along with the internals score (20 marks) to arrive at the final score (100 marks) at the end of each term.

Class VIII to X – Students of Class VIII will have two terms. They will have four Formative Assessments each term and one Summative Assessment (SA). The final grade at the end of the term will include Summative Assessment (80 marks) and internals scored (20 marks).

Classes IX (ICSE) and XI (ISC) - Students of Classes IX (ICSE) and XI (ISC) will have two terms. They will have four Formative Assessments each term.

Pre-Board Exams for Classes X (ICSE) and XII (ISC): Students of Classes X (ICSE) and XII (ISC) will have two term exams and three Pre-board exams.

Conditions for the Award of Certificate

Certificates will be awarded to candidate who reach a prescribed minimum aggregate of marks in all the six subjects offered and at least attain the pass standard in five subjects for eligibility for the I.S.C. (XII) or H.S.C Course which must include English. A pass grade in Socially Useful Productive Work (Internal assessment) is essential.

Indian School Certificate Examination [Class XI and XII] Origin

The Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations was established in 1958 by the University of Cambridge Local Examinations Syndicate with the assistance of the Inter-State Board for Anglo-Indian Education. It is registered under the Societies Registration Act NO. XXI of 1860.

Recognition

The Delhi Education Act, 1973, passed by Parliament, in Chapter I under Definitions Section 2 (s), recognizes the Council as a body conducting public examinations.

The **Indian School Certificate Examination** has been designed as an examination, through the medium of English, in accordance with the recommendations of the New Education Policy 1986, after a two-year course of studies beyond the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (Year-10) Examination or its equivalent.

Conditions of eligibility for admission to class XI

Candidates who have been awarded Pass Certificate's in the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education Examination with pass marks in five subjects including English are eligible to be admitted for the preparation course of study leading to the Indian School Certificate Examination.

The eligibility of candidates who have been awarded Pass Certificates in an equivalent examination conducted by another Examining Board will be decided by Chief Executive and Secretary of the Council. The conditions of eligibility are as follows:

The candidate must have been awarded a Pass Certificate in accordance with the requirements of the Board at an equivalent examination taken at one and the same sitting.

The Candidate must have obtained pass marks in accordance with the Regulations of the Board in English and four other written subjects.

Wordsworth English Lab

Wordsworth English Lab enhances their English learning especially for learning the right pronunciation and self-evaluation of various grammar concepts.

IXL Math Gym

IXL Math Gym is an online Mathematics practice tool which helps the children to acquire superior conceptual and operational skills.

Physical Education

Scientifically designed physical fitness activities to enable the kids to build up an active life and also a good sportive attitude.

Futsal is designed for maximum individual player growth, exciting team results and suitable for boys and girls. Children develop early motor skills combined with important social skills in a fun and safe environment.

Music/Dance

Facilitating the child to enjoy and develop interest in Music and Dance sessions.

Internationalism

ISA-International School Award is a special program designed to enable the child to explore the world.

Yoga

Yoga helps the children to develop the skill of concentration and focus by connecting the mind and body. It also helps to enhance inner strength, endurance and flexibility. Yoga is practiced from classes LKG and above.

Karate

Karate class is optional for a child which is designed to improve their self-defense techniques.

Wize Floor

Wize floor is the state of the art interactive kinesthetic learning system imported from Denmark. It is one of the first installations in the entire South India. It is an interactive floor designed to promote collective and differentiated learning styles and needs through play and physical activity. Children learn various concepts through games and activities in a fun filled interactive manner.

Zumba

Zumba is an exhilarating, effective, easy-to-follow, dance fitness-move that helps students get healthy.

Evaluation of Co-curricular activities

The performance and proficiency level of the co-curricular activities is evaluated based on grading system.

Homework

Regulation of Homework: Homework is allotted keeping in mind the health and well-being of pupils and judicious control is exercised by the class teachers, which is reviewed by the Head of School. The collaboration and co-operation of parents is essential for holistic development of the child.

The amount of written work to be done at home will be controlled and

there will be a proper division of written and reading homework.

Type of Homework: Homework will differ from subject to subject, but reasonable homework would include:

- (i) Work designed to give children practice in a particular process or operation.
- (ii) The application of principles which have been explained in the class.
- (iii) Reading (study) with a view to acquire principles, essential facts or formulae or illustrative examples.
- (iv) Collecting information relating to specified topics or for debates.
- (v) Learning poems by rote shall not exceed twelve lines.

Holiday Homework

The Upper Primary stage (VI to XII) pupils are required to keep diaries, take up one or two projects or work on a hobby, according to their interests, abilities and the economic support available from the parents.

Special Features

Value Education: Values are the path to perfection. Placing any ideal of perfection above our own personal convenience and interests expands our personality and opens it to wider and higher influences. We have a well-structured Value Education Syllabus from Sri Aurobindo's and Mother's teachings, International thought leaders and also from our own vedic literature to imbibe character, mould the right attitude and make them ready to face the world around them. We shall take full efforts in helping the children understand the importance and reap the benefits of true Value Education.

Computer Education: Computer Education has been restructured so that the curriculum is dynamic and adapted appropriately to the introduction of new tools, while simultaneously keeping a focus on conceptual learning which aids in improving stepwise thinking and logical reasoning which are not subject specific.

Circulars

All intimations will be sent by SMS briefly. Detailed Circulars will be posted on the school website and printed circulars will be sent to the parents if required.

Transport

- The School provides van transport through an outsourced service.
- Van attendant and the Transport In-Charge should be informed in writing if you plan to collect your child personally. Verbal messages will not be entertained.
- There must be no shoving or pushing while boarding or alighting from the bus. Students must not lean or extend arms and heads out of bus windows. The students should not distract drivers either by shouting or by misbehaving.
- Vans are equipped with GPS and speed limit controllers.

Newsletter

Newsletters will be published in the electronic form every month.

E-Newsletter will be published in the School's Facebook and also in the School website. Parents are requested to spend few minutes to check and appreciate the articles in the newsletter.

Dress and Belongings

- Students must be in complete school uniform on all school working days and also on field trip day. Children must wear sports uniform on Fridays.
- Parents of KG kids should ensure that the children carry one set of spare dress (colour dress) daily to school. Parents are requested to label all belongings of the children.
- Children should wear ID card on all working days.
- Children are permitted to come in colour dress during Saturdays,
 Festivals and Celebrations.
- On all exam days, children are expected to come only in School Uniform.

Colour dress code for BOYS:

- All shirts must be either a collared shirt with buttons or turtleneck.
 Tucking shirts inside of pants is optional. Shirt shall be no more than one size above the student's regular or normal size. Shirt must appropriately fit student and not be altered to form fit.
- Shirts should be always buttoned in full at all times.
- Baggy, saggy pants are not permitted. Pants must be fitted and secured around the waist area.
- Sandals, flip-flops and slippers are prohibited. Shoes with laces must be tied at all times. Shoes cannot have graffiti on them.
- Spiked hair, undercut, distracting hairstyles, streaking, dyeing is not permitted.
- Head gear of any kind such as hats, bandannas, visors, sunglasses are not permitted for wear during the school day.

Colour dress code for GIRLS:

- All blouses or tops must have sleeves.
- Distracting hairstyles, streaking, dyeing is not permitted.
- Dresses and skirts must be below the knee.
- Skin tight dresses or tops are not permittsed. Leggings, joggers and jeggings are never acceptable.
- Crocs, uggs, platform and flip-flops presenting a safety hazard may not be worn.

Parents are expected to dress up their children appropriately so that it is comfortable, free to play and protects their self-respect and dignity at all times. Any challenges on this front we may request the parents to bring a change over.

- Avoid gold ornaments for safety reasons. Stylish chains, lockets, bands, bangles, flowers, dangling earrings, anklets and other inappropriate accessories are not allowed.
- Children should come with neatly groomed hair.
- Nails should be trimmed regularly and applying of nail polish is not allowed.
- All students should carry a clean handkerchief and lunch napkin to school every day.
- Students should use only ball point pens from Grade V onwards as per ICSE instruction.

- Students are prohibited from bringing cell phones, CDs, iPods, picture magazines, sports items (cricket ball, bat, basketball), comics, video games etc. to school
- Students should not wear fancy watches to school.

Leave Policy

- Students are expected to have a minimum of 90% of the attendance.
- No leave of absence is granted except for serious reasons and only on the previous written application of parents or guardian. Leave request needs to be requested to the Principal in writing indicating the class and section of the child and the reason for the leave of absence.
- Absence without leave note for feast, weddings etc., cannot be condoned. Repeated absence for feasts, weddings etc., render the students liable for dismissal.
- In case of any emergency leave due to illness, the student must present a leave note from parents when she/he returns to the School. Failure to provide an explanation may result in the student being sent home, in which circumstances the schools disclaims all responsibility.
- Medical certificates must always be produced for illness exceeding 3 days.
- Students will not be exempted from Physical Education unless and until a valid doctor's certificate accompanied by the parent request is submitted to and approved by the Principal.
- Students should abide by the holidays as granted by the School and not prolong vacations and holidays without valid reasons.
- Attendance on the opening day and closing day of every term is compulsory.
- Student's name will be struck off the rolls and readmission will be required for any unaccounted absence from school exceeding 30 days.
- Tardy arrivals after vacations and those taking leave without prior sanction are liable to have their names struck off the roll. But, if readmitted upon their late return, they must pay the entrance fees again.
- Pupils who have been recently suffering from or exposed to any infectious disease will not be allowed to attend school unless the

period of quarantine is over which is to be certified by a registered medical practitioner.

Late coming

Students are expected to arrive at school on time. The gate will be closed by 8.10am. Students who come late has to meet the Principal along with the parent. A general warning will be given for the first and second time late comers and a memo will be issued on the third time. The child will not be admitted inside the school after the third time.

Meeting Teachers

- Parents are allowed to meet the teachers only on first Saturday of every month between 9:00 am to 11:30 am with prior appointment from the receptionist.
- Queries to the class teacher can be written in the diary.
- Parents can also email their queries to <u>inquiry@primroseschools.in</u>
 Parents should mention the student's name and class in the subject field.
- Parents are prohibited from gifting any staff member, either in kind or cash.
- If there is a request placed by any school staff for any kind of gift or monitory support, parents are requested to inform the School Coordinator / Principal immediately.

Dress code for parents to visit the school

- Dress code for parents to meet the teachers is Formal or Semi-formal wear.
- Parents will not be allowed to meet the teachers who wears shorts, round neck T-shirts, sleeveless T-shirts.
- Parents are requested to avoid transparent wear.

Rules of Discipline

- Mobile phones are not allowed inside the campus.
- Any items which is lost and found on the premises may be handed over to the reception counter which will be kept in the "Lost and Found section."
- Students are not allowed to receive visitors in school. They are not allowed to make/or receive phone calls unless the school deems it necessary.
- Any correspondence to the school should be addressed to the Principal. The full name of the child along with the class and section should be included.
- Pupils are answerable to the School Authorities for their conduct, both in and outside the school. Hence, misbehavior in the school bus, in the street and in public conveyance justifies dismissal. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, disobedience, objectionable moral influence, or a week's inexcusable absence and above all discourtesy and disrespect to teachers, are sufficient causes of dismissal.
- No absentee or late arrival may be admitted to class.
- When students are moving along corridors or up and down the stairs, as when changing classes, they must walk in SILENCE and the rule is "KFEP LEET".
- The school does not accept responsibility for the loss of books, pens, money etc. It is not advisable for the students to have money or other valuable articles with them, like gold chains, rings and no expensive wrist watches with alarms or games on it will be allowed.
- Any kind of damage done to the assests in the school premises is to be made good or to be replaced by the parents.
- All children should be particularly careful to avoid throwing garbage/ refuse anywhere in the school premises except in the baskets and bins provided for the purpose.
- Money collections of any kind for any purposes whatsoever, should never be made by the students/ parents without the Principal's previous written sanction.
- Gifts to the members of the staff or other demonstration in their honor also require previous sanction of the Principal.

Food Policy

Mother's Philosophy on Food

Help me develop a taste for food that is only simple and healthy

We firmly believe in the Mother's philosophy to provide only simple and healthy food to children. School is a place where diverse group of children come together to learn. The food that we eat should not create any kind of discomfort to others. **We believe in simple and healthy vegetarian food.** Non-vegetarian foods are not allowed in the school premises.

It is our priority to keep the environment pleasant for all the children for a better learning atmosphere. Since our classrooms are air-conditioned, the strong flavour of the food remains in the class for longer duration, resulting in discomfort among the children. It is observed that post lunch has become a challenge for the students across many classes as the strong flavor of the food evokes nausea feel. We write this as a request to the parents to follow the below given points for the benefit of our children.

- Avoid sending Non-Vegetarian dishes.
- Avoid sending strong flavored foods.
- Do not send foods that ferment soon.
- Do not send foods that will stale in a short period.
- Kindly ensure the child brings consumable quantity of food that is easy to handle.
- ❖ Pack food items in a proper container that is child friendly to open.
- Label the lunch bag and the container to help the child identify the pack with ease.
- Always send a water bottle, lunch towel, spoons and forks as required.

Let us always prefer sending simple and healthy food to our children. It is

very important to teach our children to respect their fellow beings.

Fee Rules

- Fees to be paid in cash, cheque, online or by card on or before due date (For card payments: 1.5% service charges will be levied).
- Fees to be paid as per instructions given in the fee-circular.
- Parents will kindly keep the fee receipt with them and produce it as and when required by the school for some occasional check if necessary.
- Please write the name of student and standard on the back side of the cheque.

Library Rules

- Students should make it a matter of personal pride that the books are treated with the utmost care, as if they were their own property.
- Only one book at a time may be taken.
- The attention of the librarian should be drawn to books that an intending borrower finds damaged.
- A book may not be kept beyond a fortnight unless it is not in demand. It
 may then be registered for another fortnight. For such a renewal,
 however the book must be reproduced.
- All books must be returned before the end of each term. The borrower who fails to return a book will have to pay a fine equal to the value of the book.
- Fine per day will be Rs.5 and for lost case will be the book amount.
- A pupil guilty of disobedience to the librarian or disorderly conducts, will be suspended from use of the library.

Recommendations to Parents

Parents are expected to co-operate with the school authorities by enforcing regularity and discipline, by seeing that their children prepare their lessons and by taking an active and helpful interest in the activities of the school. In particular, they are understood to have entrusted the Principal with the authority to correct and punish at his reasonable discretion. IF THERE IS ANY INFECTIOUS DISEASES AT HOME, PARENTS MUST REPORT THE FACT TO THE PRINCIPAL AT

- ONCE and should not send the students to class till the period of quarantine has passed. Do not send a sick child to school.
- PRIVATE TUITIONS ARE NOT ENCOURAGED.
- Parents should not forget to enter in this diary the specimen signature which may be referred to, if necessary.
- Parents or Guardians are requested to notify the school of any change in their address or telephone number without undue delay.
- PARENTS OR GUARDIAN ARE NOT ALLOWED TO SEE THE STUDENTS DURING SCHOOL HOURS OR INTERVIEW THE TEACHERS WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF THE PRINCIPAL. Any appointments with members of the staff should be arranged beforehand through the school office.

Other Regulations

Diary Care

- Parents should check the diary every day for homework and other instructions. Any issues, complaints can be written in the diary.
- School diary should be brought to school every day.
- Parents and guardians are to make prior appointment to meet the class teachers and restrict to the days and timings allotted for meeting the class teachers.

Medical Care

- Medicine administration: If a child requires any medicines to be administered during school hours, a written request has to be submitted by the parent.
- Students suffering from an infectious disease must produce a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner so that she/he may attend school without any risk of spreading infection.

Books and Belongings Care

- Children should handle all school property with care. They are liable to make good for all the damages they cause to school property.
- Books must be brought to school according to the daily schedule.
- Bags, shoes and other articles brought to school should have the name of the student and his/her name and class / section marked on them.

- Students should take good care of their belongings. The school will
 not be responsible for money or articles or any other valuables lost or
 stolen in the school premises.
- No books, newspapers, periodicals and expensive toys may be brought into the school premises without proper sanction.

Birthdays Celebration

- Birthdays are the special days where the child receives abundant grace from the divine. The child blossoms on this day and hence should be celebrated with love, gratitude and humility.
- The child will be blessed by the Principal, Teachers and peers in the morning assembly.
- Sharing of sweets is an option but instead of Sweets and Chocolates, organic and healthy sweets can be sent.
- The Child is encouraged to share his/her likes, good habits and aim in life in front of the morning assembly.

Admission Procedure

Admission to classes I and above are subject to availability of seats and other conditions that the management may deem fit to prescribe from time to time.

To be eligible for admission in Pre K.G. the child should be 2 years on or before 31st Dec. If the parent seeks admission for Pre KG during Vijaya Dasami, the child should have completed 2 years and 9 months by 30th September.

Issue of Transfer Certificate

If a parent wishes to withdraw a child from the school towards the end of an academic year, an application for seeking Transfer Certificate should be submitted **before 31st Jan** of that year.

For Classes I to VII TC will be issued end of March, for classes VIII and IX TC shall be issued in the month of Feb. It is recommended not to change the students during IX, X and XI, XII as annual registration for the public examinations for ICSE (Class X) happens in class IX and for ISC (class XII) happens in class XI. Migration certificates and mark list for class X, XII will be issued after the declaration of the results by the board. A processing fee of Rs. 500/- will be charged for Transfer Certificate.

Note: Parents are advised to plan for their ward's transfer from school and inform the school with the written application before 31st Jan. Transfer Certificates will be issued to those who apply for it after 31st Jan only if they pay the fees and other payments due for the First Term, of the subsequent academic year, as the school would have planned for books, uniforms considering their presence whether they continue their studies in the school or not. No discussion will be entertained under any circumstances.
