The **International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE)** is an English language curriculum offered to students to prepare them for [International Baccalaureate](#), [A Level](#) and [BTEC Level 3](#) (which is recommended for higher tier students). The IGCSE was developed by [University of Cambridge International Examinations](#).

- ✓ The IGCSE is an international alternative to many popular national curricula.
- ✓ The IGCSE is not a group award or "certificate of education".
- ✓ It is a qualification based on individual subjects of study.
- ✓ Typical "core" curricula for IGCSE candidates include
First Language, Second Language, Mathematics and one or more subjects in the Sciences.
- ✓ IGCSE candidates then choose a number of additional courses ranging from Social Sciences to Creative Arts.

Principal Ganesh is a good man. Helped poor kids too by admitting on minimum cost under some quota or RTE perhaps.


