BRUSH PAINTING - LKG

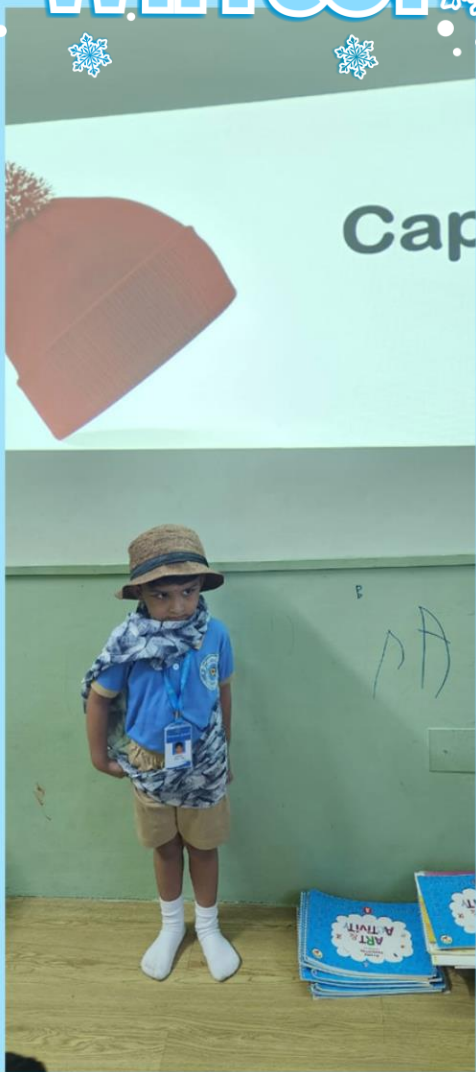
The secret to this brush technique is to let the brush do the work.

WATERMELON PAINTING

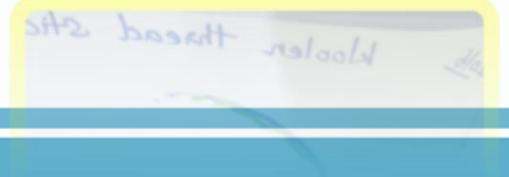
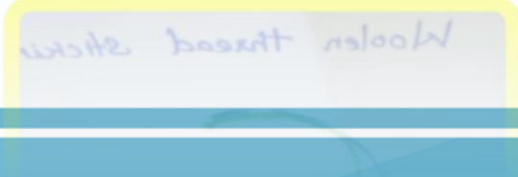
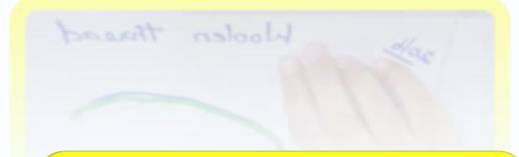

This activity helps children as they develop eye-hand coordination and fine motor skills. They are strengthening the muscles in their hands which will help them with drawing and writing.

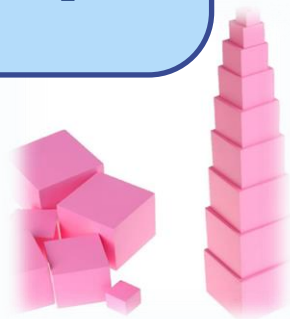


PINK TOWER BY TODDLER

Children learn social skills such as sharing, taking turns and resolving conflicts

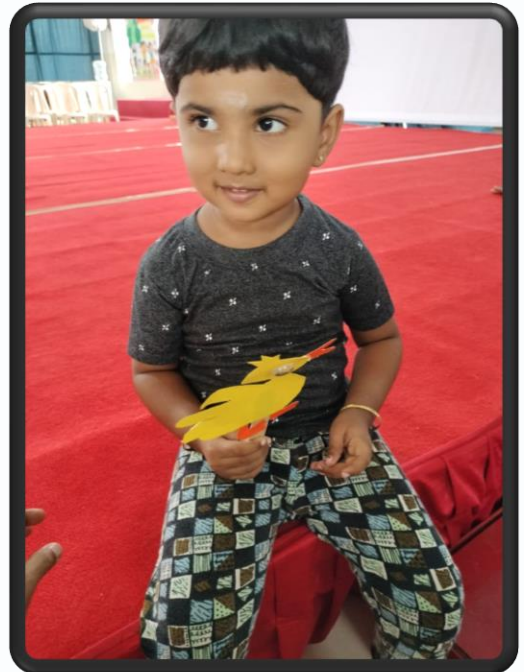


Our children actively engaged in water splash activity. They enjoyed creating waves and watching the water move and splash around them. They loved splashing water with their hands and feet.

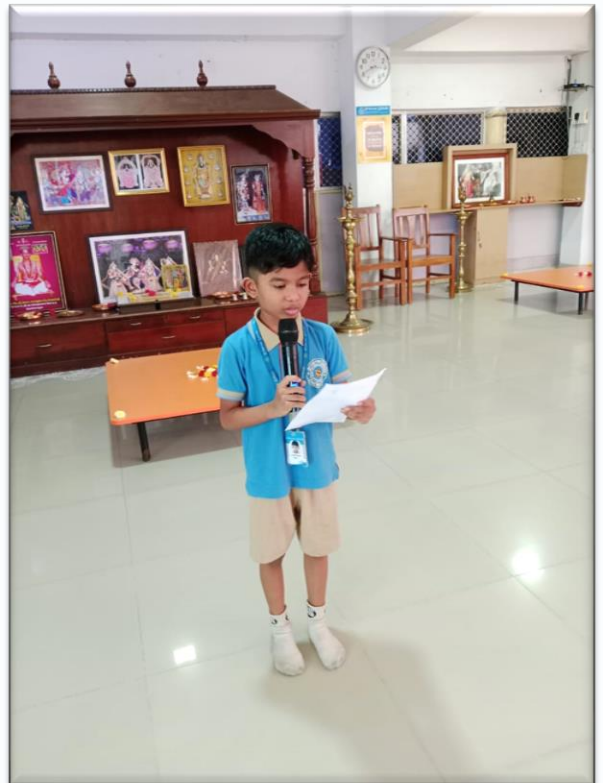


COGNITIVE ACTIVITIES

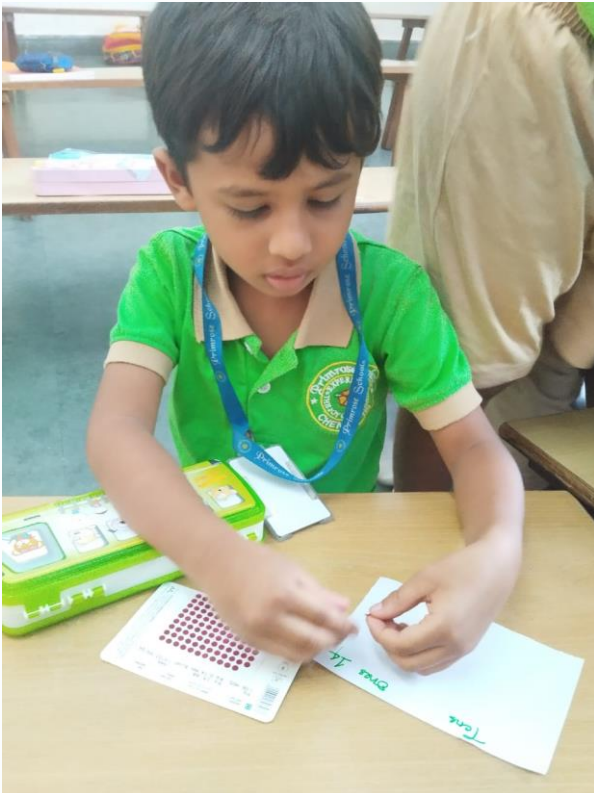
Letter recognition is important for children because it helps them develop reading and writing skills, and can also boost their confidence and motivation to learn.
