Let's continue to embrace kindness and courtesy in all our actions!



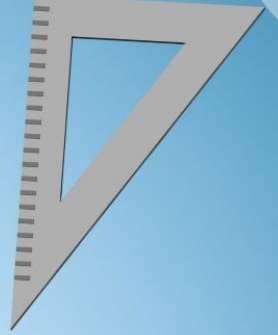
SA - II EXAM

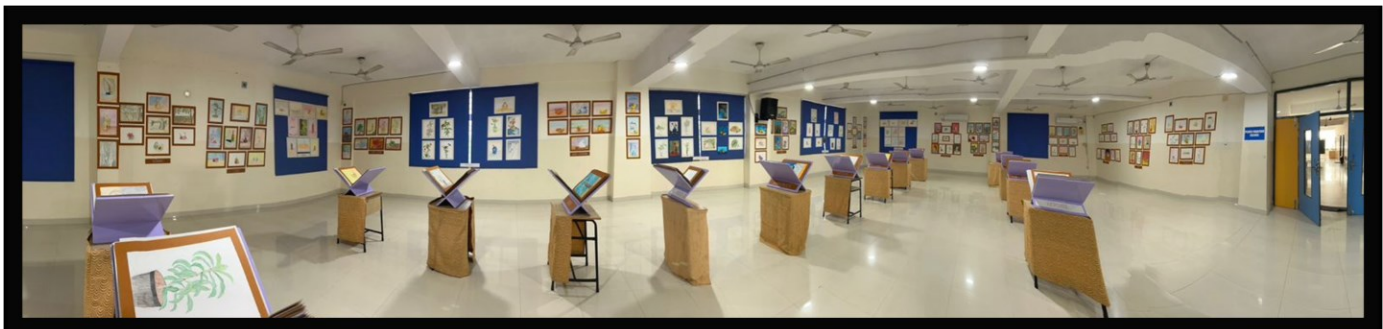

CLASS X ART EXHIBITION



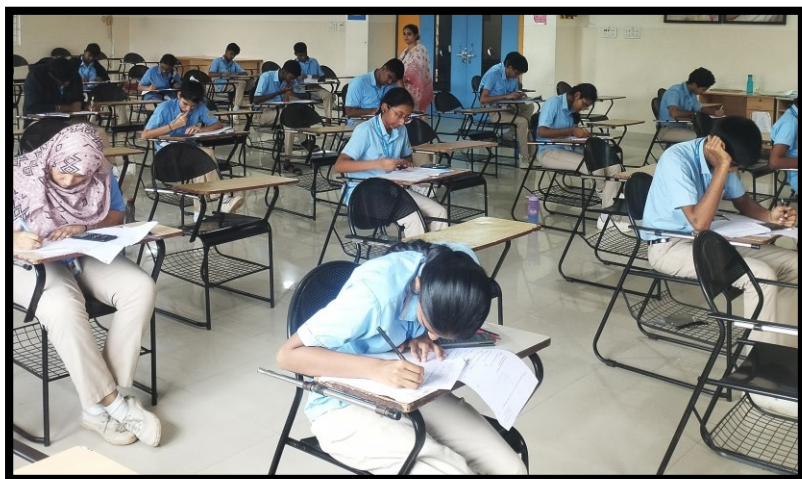

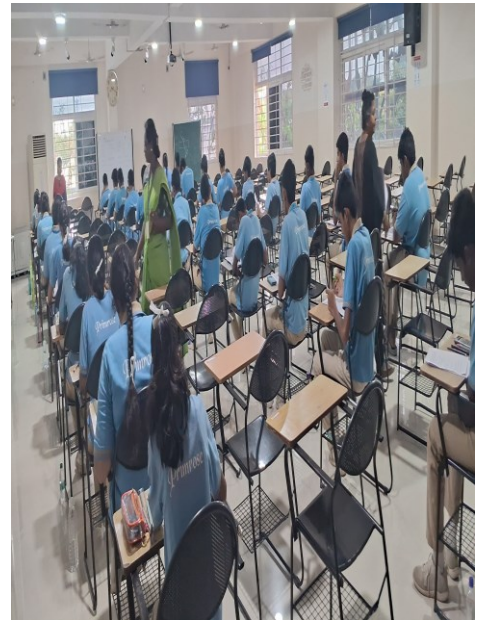
Revision examination and SA II examination conducted for the classes X and XII
