




Class 1 children's faces lit up with excitement as they carefully folded and creased their paper to create beautiful origami butterflies.


The children beamed with pride, knowing they had transformed a simple piece of paper into a work of art using their skills, creativity, and imagination.




INTERNAL ASSESSMENT
