STORY TELLING AWARDS



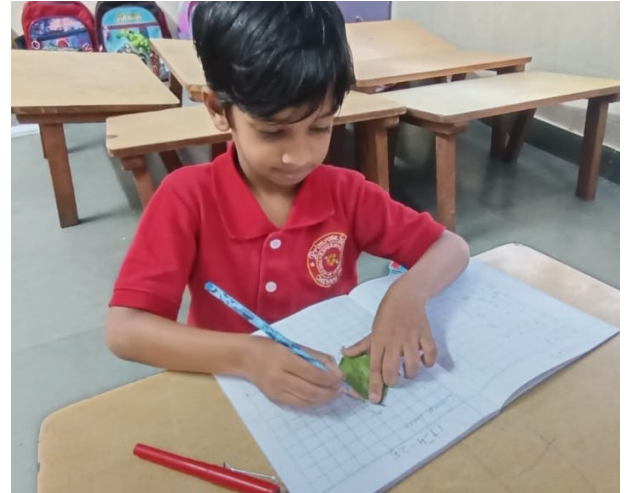

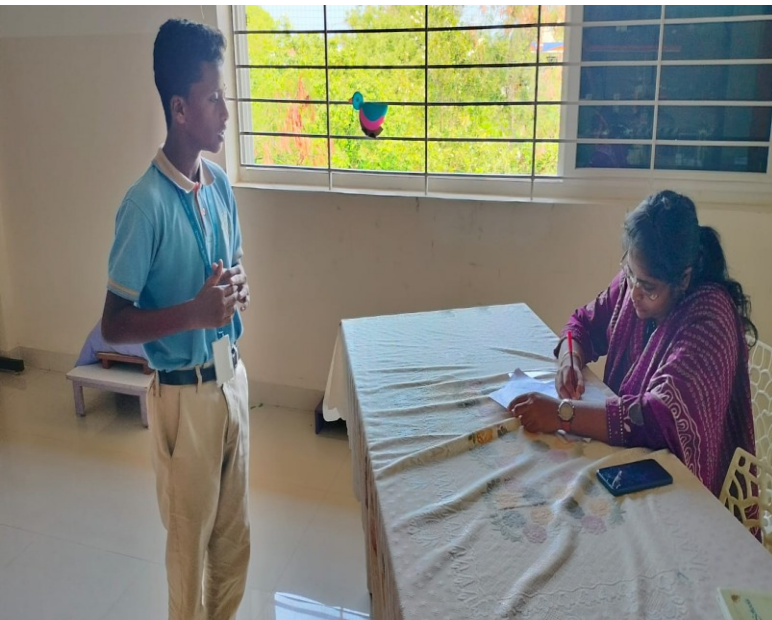


STUDENT ELECTION PANEL SELECTION (08.04.2025)

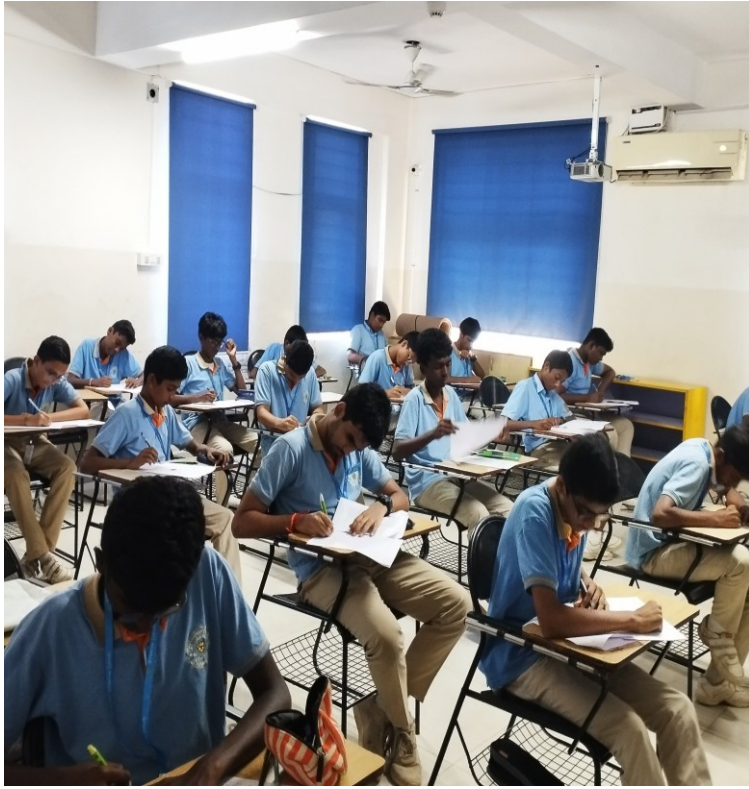

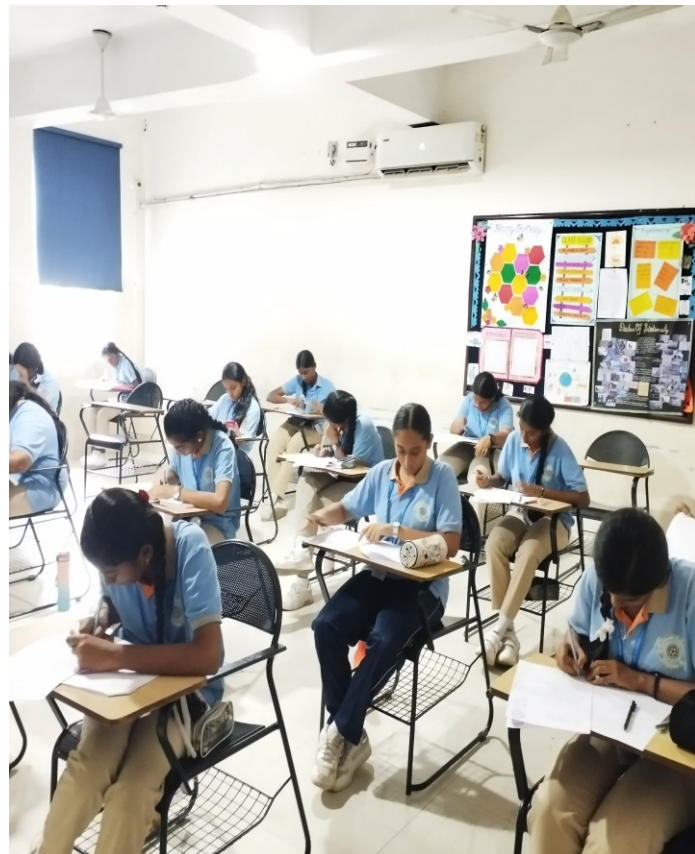


HIGH SCHOOL

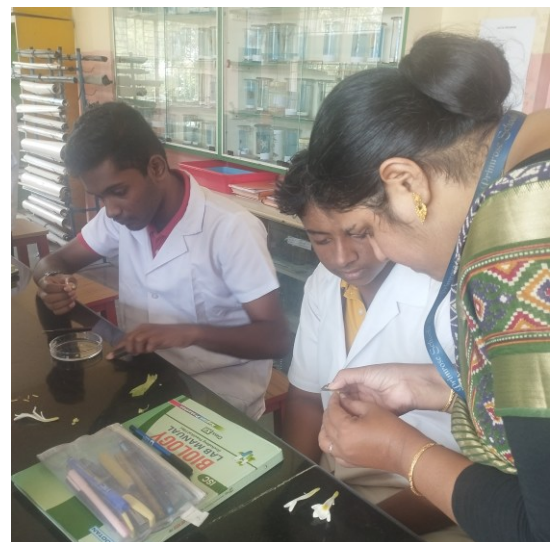
