# Self Designing Face Activity

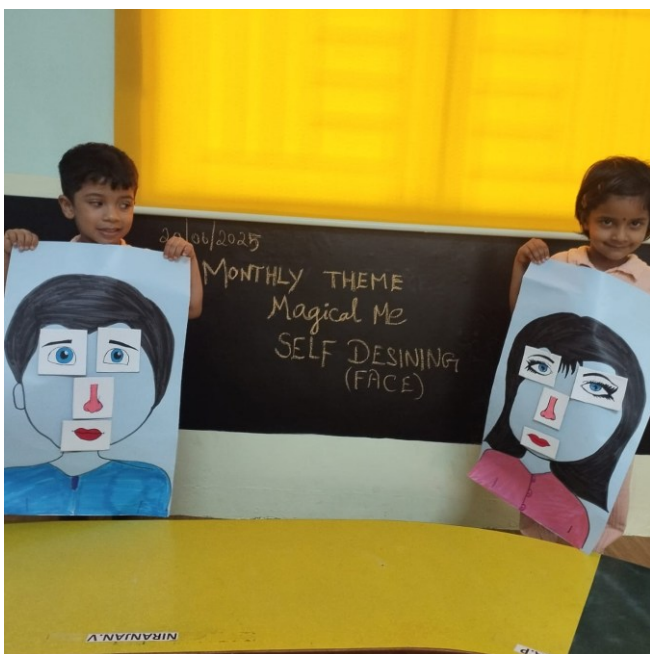

Class - 1



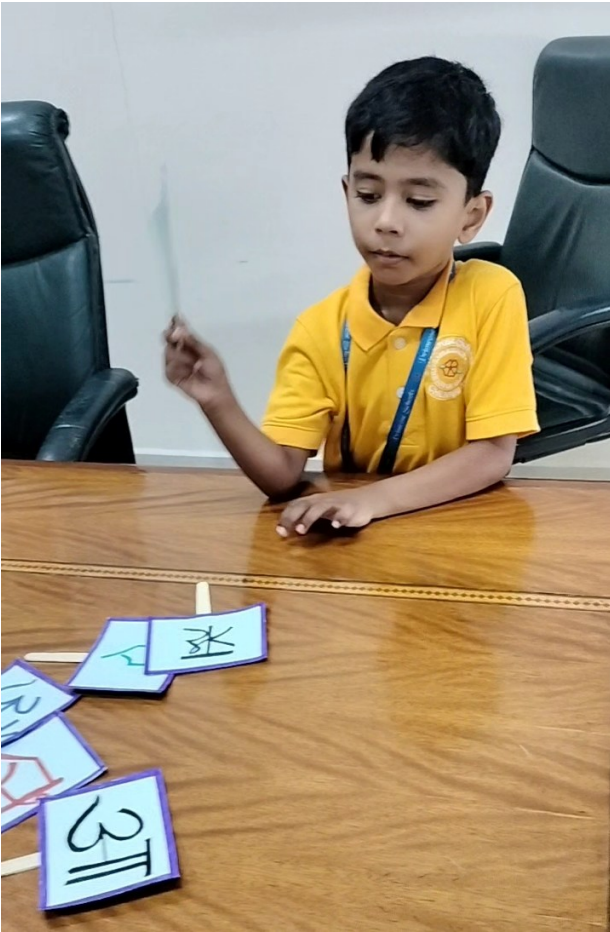

## *Identification of Swar and Vyanjan*

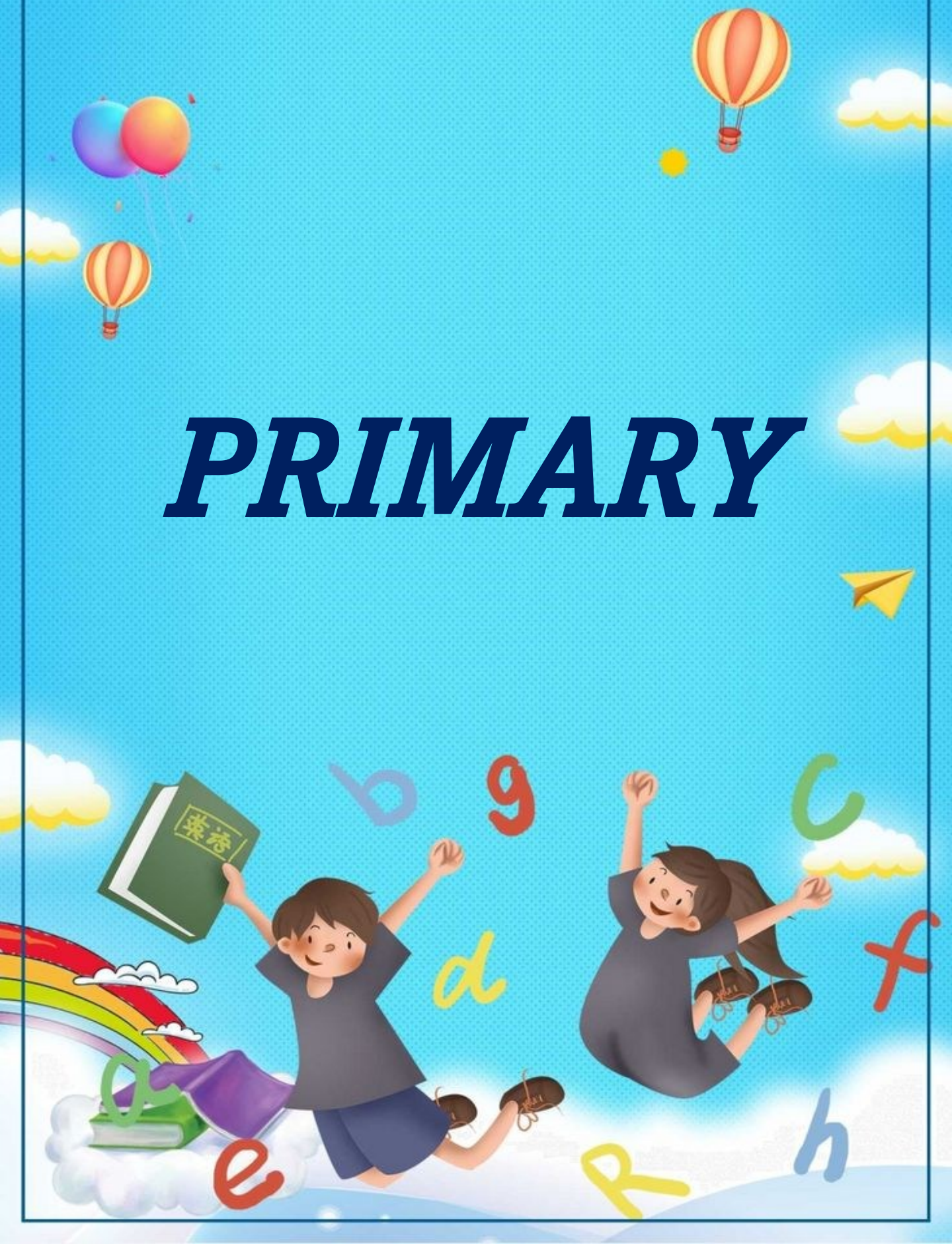
Class - 1

# CLASS II LILY – MATH INTERNAL ASSESSMENT- SHAPES



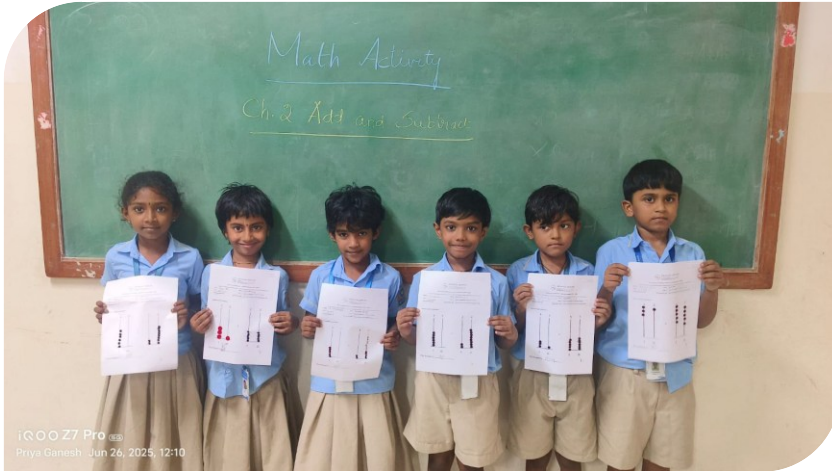
## “Learning takes shape when it’s fun!”

During our Internal Assessment, students embarked on an engaging journey through the world of geometry—identifying, exploring, and categorizing a variety of 2D and 3D shapes (from flat figures like triangles, squares, and circles to solid forms such as cubes, cylinders, cones, and spheres)—while simultaneously examining their key properties (edges, vertices, faces, symmetry) in ways that enhanced their spatial awareness, strengthened visual learning, boosted vocabulary and classification skills, and sharpened their problem-solving abilities, laying a strong foundation for future success.





# CLASS II LILY – MATH CLASS ACTIVITY – ADDITION & SUBTRACTION



**“Math is not just numbers—it’s thinking!”**

Armed with tiny, colorful bindis and chart grids, students teamed up in pairs to solve basic addition and subtraction problems—placing bindis to represent addends and differences—and turned abstract math into a tactile, visual puzzle! This playful, hands-on method strengthened their mental math skills and number sense while boosting logical reasoning, focus, fine motor coordination, and collaborative problem-solving.

## CLASS II lily – MATH CLASS ACTIVITY – **ADDITION & SUBTRACTION**

This sensory-rich activity supported mental math fluency, deepened number sense, and encouraged strategic reasoning. With each move, learners engaged discussion, made predictions, and refined their thinking—enhancing focus, collaboration, and long-term retention through concrete interaction.





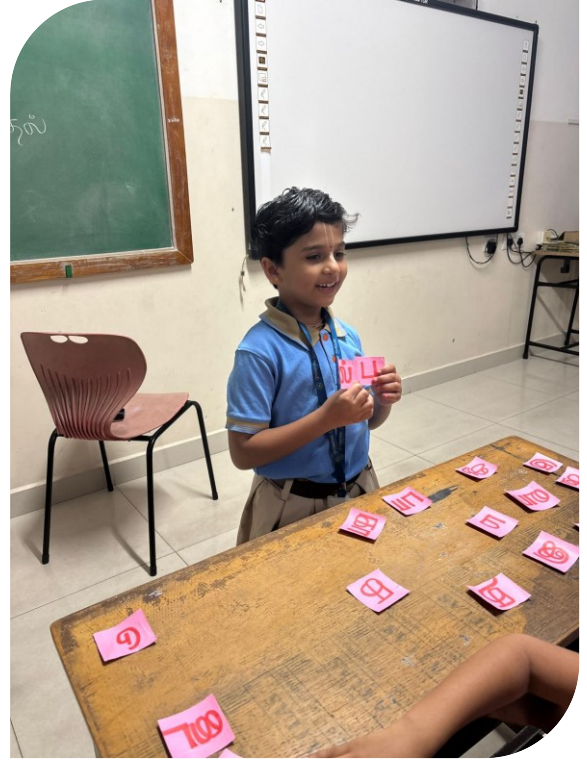
# CLASS II LILY – HINDI CLASS ACTIVITY



**“Language is the road map of culture.”**

Students dove into a lively hands-on Hindi session filled with vocabulary games and word-building challenges. Working in pairs, they crafted words using tiles, flashcards, and storytelling prompts—turning each term into a fun puzzle to decode and pronounce. This joyful, playful approach supercharged their vocabulary retention and sparked creative thinking, thanks to active recall, repeated exposure, emotional engagement, and social interaction that anchor learning more effectively than rote drills

# CLASS II LOTUS – TAMIL CLASS ACTIVITY



**“Learn your roots, speak your soul.”**

Class II Lotus students recently immersed themselves in a vibrant, hands-on Tamil-letter session—exploring அ to ஔ and க் to ஃ through interactive story reading and pronunciation drills. Using lively folk tales and sound-rich practice, they traced letters, identified vowel-consonant combinations, and vocalized each character with joy. This multisensory approach not only sharpened their phonemic awareness and script recognition but also deepened their cultural connection—rooting them in Tamil heritage while building strong linguistic foundations.



# CLASS III LILY – SCIENCE CLASS ACTIVITY



**“Curiosity is the wick in the candle of learning.”**

Guided by their curiosity, students studied internal organs using a life-size classroom dummy with removable organ models. They observed, placed, and identified parts like the heart, lungs, liver, and stomach—aligning each organ in its correct position. This tactile exploration fostered inquiry-based learning, sharpened scientific reasoning, and deepened body awareness. By actively engaging with the dummy, they built strong conceptual understanding, memory, and an early appreciation for how their own bodies work.

After the hands-on dummy activity, students further expanded their learning using 3D anatomical models—removing and placing organ replicas to explore systems like the circulatory, respiratory, and digestive systems. By interacting with anatomically accurate models, children visualized the spatial relationships between organs, understood systemic integration, and explored how these parts work together in the body.



# CLASS III LILY – SCIENCE CLASS ACTIVITY



This immersive, multisensory method improved comprehension of complex structures, enhanced visuospatial reasoning, and boosted long-term retention of scientific knowledge. The tactile and visual nature of the models helped solidify abstract concepts into tangible understanding.





# CLASS III LILY – MATH CLASS ACTIVITY– ADDITION



**“Every sum solved is a step toward success.”**

Prim buds, teamed up in small groups to solve addition problems using colorful bindis as manipulatives. Each learner placed bindis on chart grids to represent numbers, collaborated to find sums, and offered peer feedback. This vibrant, tactile method not only builds number fluency but also nurtures teamwork, peer reasoning, and shared problem-solving skills. Strategically organizing bindis into “mastered” and “review” groups encouraged strategy-setting and self-assessment.

# CLASS III LILY – MATH INTERNAL ASSESSMENT- PATTERNS

**“Patterns are the rhythm of numbers.”**

Students used vibrant beads threaded in sequence on colorful threads to identify and extend numerical and visual patterns (e.g., red-blue-red-blue or expanding numerically). They practiced creating, predicting, and continuing repeating and growing patterns in small groups. This tactile, visually engaging activity developed their logical thinking, pattern recognition, and prediction skills while promoting fine motor control and collaborative discussion.



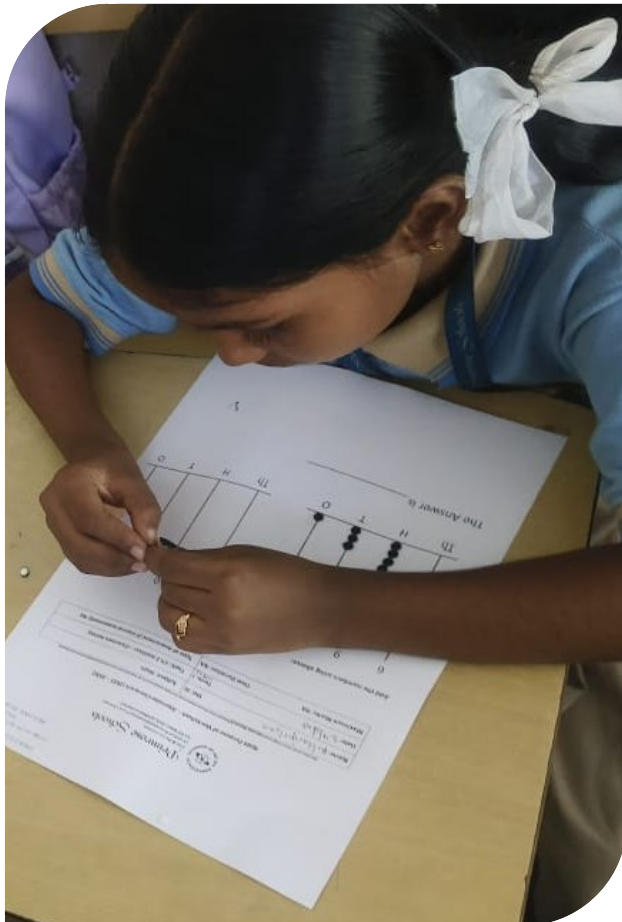


# CLASS III LOTUS– MATH INTERNAL ASSESSMENT - PATTERNS




After mastering basic pattern-building with beads and thread, students were invited to create their own complex sequences, describe them aloud (e.g. “red-blue-yellow: A-B-C”), and challenge classmates to predict or extend them. This process honed their logical reasoning, pattern abstraction, and predictive thinking, while fine-tuning their working memory, cognitive flexibility, and verbal articulation.

# CLASS III LOTUS – MATH CLASS ACTIVITY- ADDITION



After practicing sums using bindis in group activity, students moved to analyze and explain their strategies to peers, comparing approaches such as grouping bindis visually or mentally. This allowed them to reflect on reasoning, refine their methods, and gain confidence in articulating their thought processes.
