



## Class III Boys- Kho-Kho Team Selection







## Proficiency Award








The **Proficiency Award**Ceremony 2025 was held to recognize and celebrate the outstanding academic achievements of our students.

## Core Message of 19th Annual Day



A modern lifestyle dominated by late waking, irregular routines, gadget dependency, junk food consumption, and emotional instability is portrayed, and the negative effects of these habits on health, behavior, and family relationships are highlighted. A mysterious time-travel device is discovered, through which a group of students is unexpectedly transported to different time periods. In the future, a highly mechanized and robotic world is witnessed, where the absence of humans is explained as a consequence of long-term unhealthy habits. It is revealed that constant intake of processed foods, excessive use of medicines, exposure to harmful chemicals, lack of physical activity, and continuous attachment to screens gradually weakened human immunity, reduced natural thinking ability, disturbed emotional balance, and ultimately made humans dependent on machines for almost every task. Stories, demonstrations, and visual examples are shown to explain how natural intelligence—represented by common sense, emotional strength, physical fitness, and balanced judgment—was slowly lost. The students are urged to travel to the past to understand how these qualities were once cultivated.

# Core Message of 19th Annual Day

In the 1980s, a simple, peaceful, and healthier lifestyle is observed. Natural and home-cooked foods are consumed regularly, outdoor games are played for physical fitness, early waking and disciplined routines are followed, emotional stability is practiced through supportive family interactions, and strong bonds are maintained within neighborhoods and communities. Traditional practices such as using clay pots for cooling, engaging in arts like rangoli, and spending time in nature are witnessed, all of which contribute to sharper minds and stronger bodies. After these experiences are deeply understood, the students are brought back to the present time, where a visible transformation is shown in their habits and attitudes. A shift toward healthy eating, reduced screen time, improved discipline, increased physical activity, and a renewed appreciation for natural living is demonstrated. The central message is conveyed that the future can be safeguarded only when natural intelligence is preserved, when healthy lifestyle choices are practiced, and when technology is used with awareness and balance rather than dependence.
