LKG

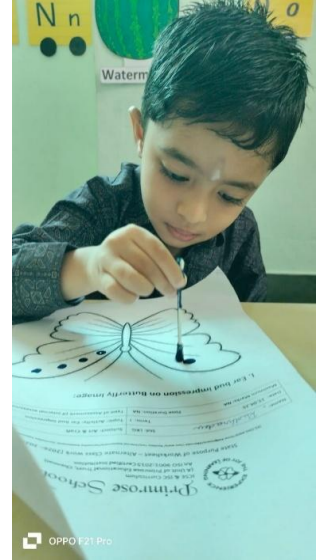


Children explored a fun and creative art activity by dabbing cotton on a duck outline, enhancing their fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination.

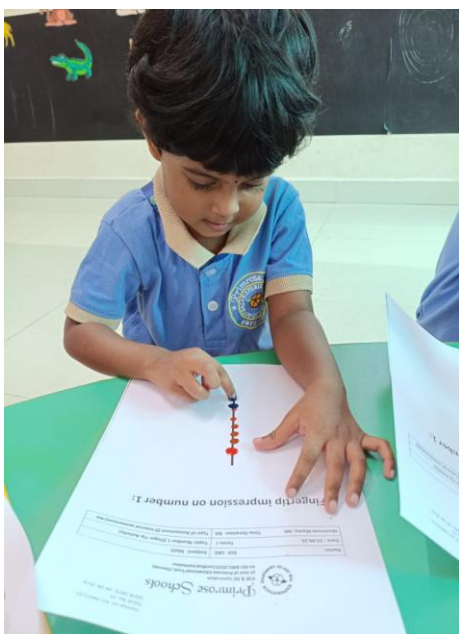


Fingerprint impression on number 1

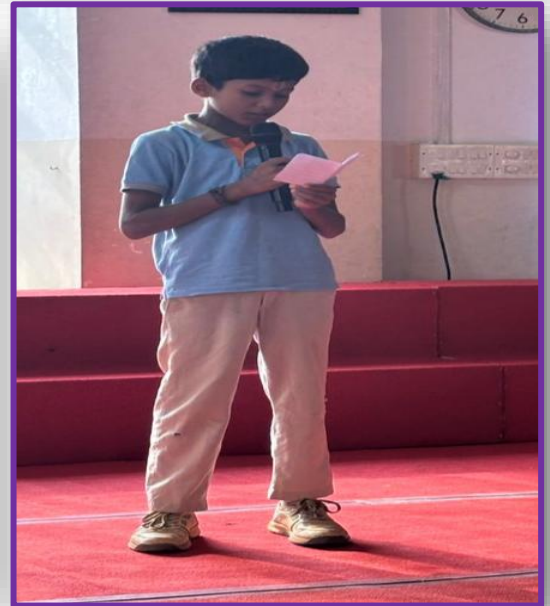
Class VII Lotus Assembly

Batmition Selection Class 6 To 8



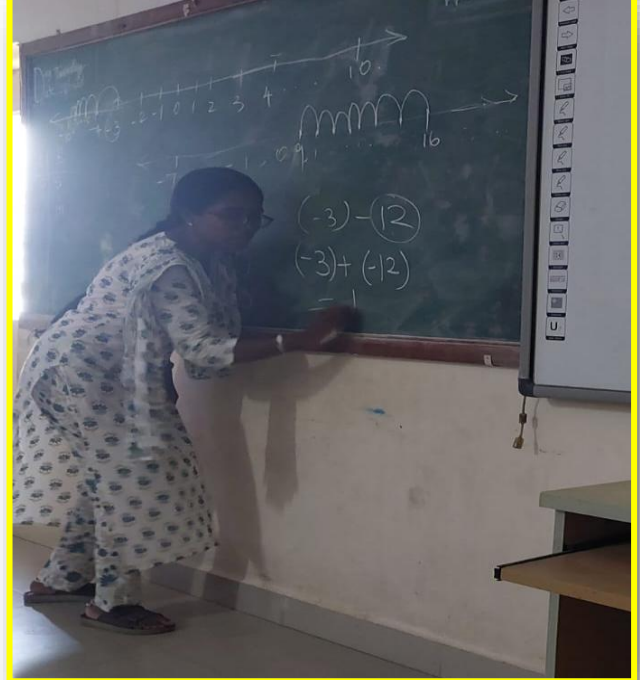

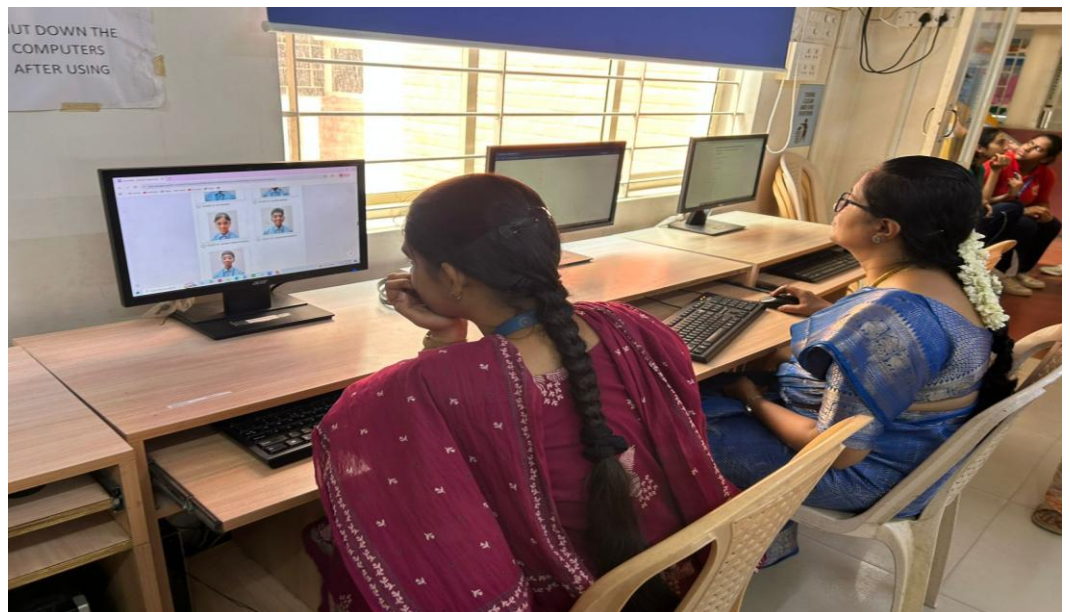


10.04.2026 School Cabinet Election

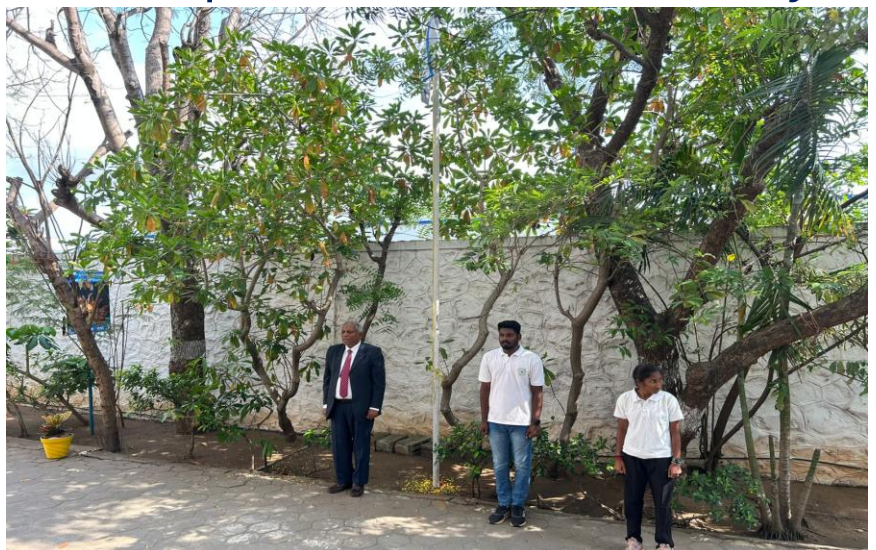


17.04.2026 Investiture Ceremony

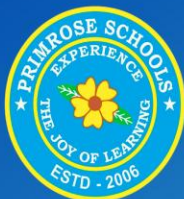
